ABOUT THE CLASSES:

Swami Vivekananda Cultural Centre, Embassy of India, Seoul is announcing Online Classes for Kathak, Bollywood Dance, Folk Dance and Light Hindustani Music from 1st March 2021. The Classes will be conducted on a suitable Online platform, guidelines for which are given below.

GUIDELINES:

- 1) Classes will be conducted in English.
- 2) Online classes will be without fees, but registration fee of KW 10,000 is mandatory.
- 3) Depending on the Covid-19 restrictions, the classes will be shifted to offline mode for which normal fees will be charged.
- 4) Hindi Song includes Patriotic Song, Ghazal, Bhajan, and Bollywood Song.
- 5) Folk Dance will include Ghoomar, Garba, Kajari and Bihu Dance.
- 6) Kathak Beginner course (Level 1) will be for 6 months duration.
- 7) Kathak Intermediate course (Level 2) for those who have passed beginner level or having a suitable level of knowledge of the dance form will be for one year duration.
- 8) Kathak Advanced course (Level 3) for those who have passed intermediate course (level 2) will be for one year duration.
- 9) Once the semester starts, there is NO option for changing the classes. It will only be available on the recommendation of the Instructor.
- 10) Registration/Tuition fee is NOT refundable after commencement of the Session.
- 11) Certificate of completion of the course may be ONLY given to those who complete the full course (6 months or 1 year) with 100 % of attendance.
